Adult / Child Safety Rules

WATCH OUT FOR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES

There will be ZERO TOLERANCE for any physical or verbal abuse between players, parents, coaches, officials, trainers or others present at games and practices. As coaches, you must warn players, parents and others that this cannot occur. If it does, you must report this immediately to the Amityville Soccer League Board and it will be dealt with appropriately. At all times, err on the side of caution.

Coaches must follow the "2 DEEP" policy requiring the presence of 2 adults at all games and practices. Coaches and any adults training or helping out cannot violate this "2 DEEP" policy as it puts them at risk for false accusations by unscrupulous children or their parents. Moreover, if there is an adult "bad apple" in ASL's system (or is offering help from the sidelines) who is allowed to operate alone, this could put our unsuspecting children at risk of harm. If any coaches observe any untoward behavior by any other players, coaches, parents, officials, trainers or others, you must report this to the ASL Board immediately. Err on the side of caution.

Parents must be instructed that they are absolutely prohibited from leaving other children, not on the team, unattended at games and practices. Please do not allow this to occur and if any parents continue this practice after being warned, please this to the attention of the ASL Board.

In encouraging that all coaches "err on the side of caution" in terms of reporting any untoward behavior, any incident reported will, upon request, be dealt with on a strictly confidential basis. You can email the entire board at:
